2353.	compensation	n	money that you pay to someone because you are responsible for injuring them or damaging something; money paid for work

2355.	compound	n	combining two or more parts to form something new
2356.	occasionally	adv	not happening often
2357.	spin	v	to turn or cause someone or something to turn around repeatedly
2358.	desert	n	an area of very dry land that is usually covered with sand and is very hot
2359.	operator	n	a person who uses and controls something such as a machine, device, or business; someone who operates something
