1206.	rain	n	water that falls in drops from clouds in the sky
1207.	cool	adj	somewhat cold : not warm or hot
1208.	suggestion	n	an idea about what someone should do or how someone should behave
1209.	defense	n	the act of protecting someone from attack
1210.	distance	n	the amount of space between two places or things
1211.	north	n	the direction that is to your left when you are facing the rising sun
