2104.	specialist	n	someone who has a lot of experience, knowledge, or skill in a particular subject
2105.	formula	n	a plan, rule or method for doing or making something
2106.	achievement	n	when you succeed in doing something good, usually by working hard
2107.	innovation	n	a new idea or method that is being tried for the first time, or the use of such ideas or methods
2108.	festival	n	a series of special events, or performances that often takes place over several days
2109.	coverage	n	the way a newspaper or television program reports an event or subject
2110.	pitch	v	in baseball, to throw the ball towards the hitter; to try to persuade someone to buy or decide something

2120.	era	n	a period of time in history that is special for a particular reason

2122.	volunteer	v	to offer to do something without being asked or told to do it
